MAYORAL ORDINANCE NO. 10 dated 24/04/2026

SUBJECT: REVOCATION OF THE EXTRAORDINARY COMMISSIONER'S ORDINANCE NO. 18 DATED 15.10.2025 CONCERNING: TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ACCESS TO THE PISETTA VIA FERRATA DUE TO THE DETACHMENT OF A ROCK SLAB FROM MOUNT GARZOLET.

THE MAYOR

Recalling the Extraordinary Commissioner's Ordinance No. 18 dated 15.10.2025, which temporarily established a prohibition of access to the Pisetta via ferrata due to the detachment of a rock slab from Mount Garzolet;

Highlighting that on 16.04.2026, safety works were carried out and completed by expert personnel through the rock scaling (disgaggio) of the dangerous section, as reported in the site condition report signed by Geologist Dr. Silvio Alberti, dated 17.04.2026 (Prot. No. 3481), which certifies that, following the scaling carried out on the detachment niche, the pre-event safety conditions have not only been restored, but improved;

Considering therefore, since the conditions of imminent danger have ceased, that the previous ordinance can be revoked, making access to the Pisetta via ferrata available once again;

Recalling Law No. 131 of September 12, 2025 (Provisions for the recognition and promotion of mountain areas), and in particular the provisions regarding the use of hiking trails, which formally establish the principle of "conscious and self-responsible use". Under the aforementioned legislation, the mountain environment is characterized by objective and unavoidable risks; therefore, the negligent or imprudent behavior of the hiker (e.g., incorrect assessment of one's own abilities, use of inadequate equipment, disregard of weather conditions) constitutes a "fortuitous event" for the purposes of civil liability (with the application of Art. 1227 of the Civil Code), establishing that the frequentation of via ferratas occurs at the user's sole risk and peril;

Recalling also:

- Articles 6, paragraph 4, and 7, paragraph 3 of the Highway Code (Legislative Decree April 30, 1992, No. 285);
- The Code of Local Authorities (C.E.L.) approved by Regional Law May 3, 2018, No. 2, and in particular Art. 61;
- The Executive Management Plan 2026–2027, approved by Municipal Executive Board Resolution No. 10 of January 27, 2026;;

Deeming it appropriate to revoke the previous ordinance in question;



DIRECTS

1. **To revoke**, for the reasons stated in the premise, the Extraordinary Commissioner's Ordinance No. 18 dated 15.10.2025.
2. **The reopening** of access to the "Ferrata Pisetta" located on Mount Garzolet.
3. **To remind** all users that the approach and subsequent traversal of the via ferrata, pursuant to Law 131/2025, occur at their own risk and peril. Hikers are required to face it with the utmost caution, proceeding under their own exclusive responsibility and adopting all individual safety measures required for via ferratas (helmet, harness, approved shock absorber/lanyard).
4. **To specify** that this Authority considers itself relieved and indemnified from any civil or criminal liability that, due to the facts or provisions of this ordinance, may arise to third parties, it being understood that this ordinance is issued without prejudice to the rights of third parties.

Legal Notices

A judicial appeal against this provision may be lodged with the Regional Administrative Court (T.R.G.A.) of Trento within 60 days pursuant to Art. 29 of Legislative Decree No. 104 of 02.07.2010.
